### **Level I: Description**

1. What do you think this is a photograph of?
2. What kind of details do you notice about the people in the photograph?
3. What period of time do you think this photograph was taken in?

### **Level II: Interpretation**

1. What do you notice about how the children are dressed?
2. What is the racial make-up of the group?
3. What can you tell about the financial status of the children by this photograph?

### **Level III: Analysis**

1. What does this photograph tell you about Urbana during this period of time?
2. What does this photograph tell you about race relations during this time?
