Level II: Interpretation

1. How do you think these items were found?
2. What do you think these items were used for?
3. Why do you think the items are shaped the way they are?

Level III: Analysis

1. Do these items tell you anything about the culture that used them?
2. Do you think that these are the only two items like this? Why or why not?
3. What other materials might have been used with this item to make it useful?
