Level I: Description

- 1. What does the document say?
- 2. What kind of material was this written on?
- 3. Was there any direct evidence of witchcraft in this documentation?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. Do you believe this really happened?
- 2. Why does the language sound different?
- 3. What do you think happened because of this deposition?

Level III: Analysis

- 1. What would you do if this happened to you or a loved one?
- 2. Do you think something like the witch trials could ever happen again? Why or why not?
- 3. Would you admit to being a witch if convicted of witchcraft? Why or why not?
