### **Level I: Description**

1. What time period do you think this tool came from?
2. What kind of primary source is this?
3. Why is one end more pointed than the other?

### **Level II: Interpretation**

1. Why do you think it came from this time period?
2. How do you think this tool was used?
3. How do you think this tool was created?

### **Level III: Analysis**

1. What kind of people used this item? Back up your prediction with a reason.
2. Create a story where the people that use this item use it for a bad reason.
3. Relate this item to something that would have the same function in our world today.
