Level I: Description

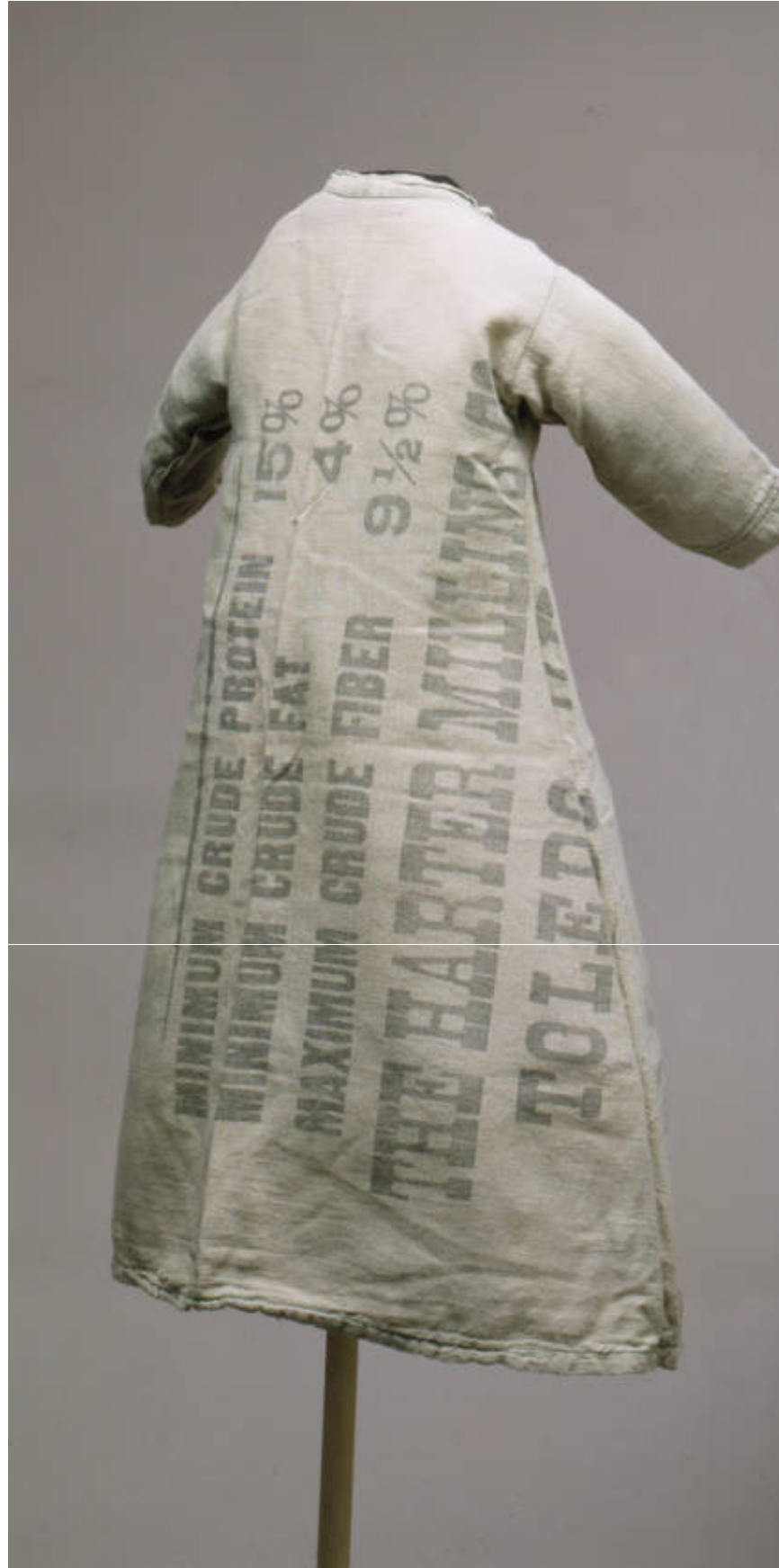
1. What is this item of clothing?
2. Who do you think would wear this?
3. What is it made from?

Level II: Interpretation

1. What did you notice about the material of this garment?
2. What might this material have been used for originally?

Level III: Analysis

1. Why do you think this was used for a garment?
2. How can you tell this garment is not from today?
3. What does using this material for a garment tell you about this time period?
