Allow students, in groups or individually, to examine the photograph located at the above link while answering the questions below in order. The questions are designed to guide students into a deeper analysis of the source and sharpen associated cognitive skills.

### **Level I: Description**

1. How many groups of people are in the photo? Who are they?
2. How are the men dressed?

### **Level II: Interpretation**

1. Would the Ku Klux Klan be allowed to march today?
2. How do you think the citizens feel?

### **Level III: Analysis**

1. Why do you think they marched at night?
2. Why do you think there are no African-Americans in the photo?
