**Level 1: Description**

1. What do you see in this photograph?
2. What would this be used for?
3. Describe the condition of what is pictured.

**Level 2: Interpretation**

1. When was this built?
2. Who would have built this?
3. Where might this be located?

**Level 3: Analysis**

1. What can you interpret about the surroundings in this picture?
2. Besides the common use, what other purpose(s) could this have served?
3. What do you imagine one would find when they reach the top?
