Answer

People: Robert Fludd, Andrea Alciato

Ways in which they were used: sometimes to entertain, to explain the hidden mysteries of the natural world (astronomy), used by many churches to explain the mysteries of the scripture, help alchemists to explain their work, to be amorous in nature and often used to explain simple basic truths.
