Allow students, in groups or individually, to examine the photograph located at the above link while answering the questions below in order. The questions are designed to guide students into a deeper analysis of the source and sharpen associated cognitive skills.

Level I: Description

- 1. What are the objects that you see in this photograph?
- 2. What is the object that is parked between the cars?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. What do you see in this photograph that seems out of place?
- 2. How can you tell that this photograph was taken during the day?

Level III: Analysis

- 1. What time period do you think this photograph was taken in?
- 2. Based on what you see, do you think that this photograph may have been taken in an area that had a lot of farmland?
