Allow students, in groups or individually, to examine the photograph located at the above link while answering the questions below in order. The questions are designed to guide students into a deeper analysis of the source and sharpen associated cognitive skills.

Level I: Description

1. What are the objects that you see in this photograph?
2. What is the object that is parked between the cars?

Level II: Interpretation

1. What do you see in this photograph that seems out of place?
2. How can you tell that this photograph was taken during the day?

Level III: Analysis

1. What time period do you think this photograph was taken in?
2. Based on what you see, do you think that this photograph may have been taken in an area that had a lot of farmland?
