Level 2: Interpretation

- 1. When do you think this photograph might have been taken? Why?
- 2. What potential dangers do you see in the photograph?
- 3. Do the children appear to be enjoying the playground equipment?

Level 3: Analysis

- 1. What does the photograph tell you about the region/season?
- 2. Why do you think the children seem to be dressed differently from one another?
- 3. Explain how your playground is the same and different from the one in the photograph?
