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Grade level: 7

Allow students, in groups or individually, to examine the photograph while answering the questions below in order. The questions are designed to guide students into a deeper analysis of the source and sharpen associated cognitive skills.

Level I: Description

- 1. What details do you notice in the picture?
- 2. What jumps out at you or is shocking to you visually?
- 3. Based on the breaking news you heard about this weekend, where do you think this is?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. The caption says that much of this particular damage was caused by a tsunami that occurred right after the earthquake. How/Why do you feel these two events are linked?
- 2. List the ways this community might be affected.

Level III: Analysis

- 1. What does this photograph tell you about this region?
- 2. Do you feel other nations should step in with aid? Why or why not. If so, what forms of help do you feel other countries could provide?
- 3. Imagine this were your community, now list the first 3 words that come to your mind. Explain what you mean by each.
