## Grade level: 5

**Primary Source:** Citizenship Class for Immigrants Photograph, c. 1930s, Work Projects Administration Photographer, Ohio Historical Society, Ohio Writers Program; WPA Project Collection, P 193/10/10.

Allow students, in groups or individually, to examine the photograph one at a time while answering the questions below in order. The questions are designed to guide students into a deeper analysis of the source and sharpen associated cognitive skills.

## Level I: Description

- 1. In what age group are the people in the photograph?
- 2. What important objects do you notice in the photograph?
- 3. Do the people in the photograph appear to be school-age?

## Level II: Interpretation

- 1. What do you think the people in the photograph are doing?
- 2. What clues are you using to determine what the people are doing?
- 3. Can you tell the time period of the photograph? How?

## Level III: Analysis

- 1. How is what is going on in the photograph important to being an American?
- 2. What do all of the people in the photograph have in common?
- 3. Can you infer anything about the everyday lives of the people in the photograph?
