Level I: Description

- 1. Is it an overcast day?
- 2. Are there any neighboring houses?
- 3. Is it a photograph of one house or two?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. How much longer will this house stand?
- 2. Does this house have a foundation or a cellar?

Level III: Analysis

- 1. Will the owner be able to live in this house again?
- 2. Does this house sit upon a hill?
- 3. How high did the water level rise on this house?
