- 2. What kind of primary source is this?
- 3. Why is one end more pointed than the other?

## **Level II: Interpretation**

- 1. Why do you think it came from this time period?
- 2. How do you think this tool was used?
- 3. How do you think this tool was created?

## Level III: Analysis

- 1. What kind of people used this item? Back up your prediction with a reason.
- 2. Create a story where the people that use this item use it for a bad reason.
- 3. Relate this item to something that would have the same function in our world today.
