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Grade level: 4

Primary Source Citation: Fort Ancient artifacts, images from *Our Ohio: Exploring Our Heritage*, Volume III, Think TV Network.

Allow students to examine the artifacts located below while answering the questions. These questions will prepare students to think critically when observing primary source documents, particularly photographs.

Level I: Description

- 1. What does the object look like?
- 2. What are any special, unusual or interesting features of the object?
- 3. What might the object be made from?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. What kinds of activities might the Late-Prehistoric Ohioans have been engaged in while using the object?
- 2. How do you think the Fort Ancient people made these objects?
- 3. What kinds of modern-day tasks could you do with these items?

Level III: Analysis

- 1. How would you compare and contrast a task like fishing or styling your hair in today's times with how the Late-Prehistoric Indians of Ohio did the same tasks?
- 2. Why is it important for archaeologists and historians to study and interpret the lives of the Late-Prehistoric Indians?
