- 1. What do you see in these photographs?
- 2. Who do you see in these photographs?

## **Level II: Interpretation**

- 1. What time period were these photographs taken in?
- 2. How can you tell?
- 3. What is occurring in these photographs?

## **Level III: Analysis**

- 1. Why is this event occurring?
- 2. Is this a violent protest?
- 3. Do you think this protest achieved its goal?
