Allow students, in groups or individually, to examine the photograph below (and located at the above link) while answering the questions below in order. The questions are designed to guide students into a deeper analysis of the source and sharpen associated cognitive skills.

Level I: Description

1. How many groups of people are in the photo? Who are they?
2. How are the men dressed?

Level II: Interpretation

1. Would the Ku Klux Klan be allowed to march today?
2. How do you think the citizens feel?

Level III: Analysis

1. Why do you think they marched at night?
2. Why do you think there are no African-Americans in the photo?
