Level I: Description

- 1. What is this dress made out of?
- 2. Is this dress the same color as the material it is made from and if not, why is it this color?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. When do you think this dress was worn?
- 2. Why is the dress a three-piece dress and not a one-piece dress?

Level III: Analysis

- 1. What does the design of the dress tell you about the fashion standards of this time period?
- 2. What economic level do you believe the owner of this dress belonged to?
