Level I: Description

- 1. Can you describe what might be going on in this photograph?
- 2. Pick 2 things that stand out to you in this photograph.

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. Where might you find this important part of American history?
- 2. What do you think this might be a photograph of?

Level III: Analysis

- 1. How has transportation changed since this photograph was taken?
- 2. How does this photograph help you understand what you've read in your textbook on the canal systems in Ohio?
