## Level I: Description

- 1. What type of source is this?
- 2. What can you tell of the landscape in the image?
- 3. Is this source dated, if so, when is it dated?

## Level II: Interpretation

- 1. Where is this image taken?
- 2. How does image relate to the conflict between the United States and the Soviet Union?
- 3. What components of destruction are noticed in the image?

## Level III: Analysis

- 1. Why do you believe this source was important to American intelligence?
- 2. How do you believe the American people would have reacted at the time to viewing this image?
- 3. What response would you suggest for the United States government to have taken after viewing this image?
