Level I: Description

- 1. What details do you see in the photograph?
- 2. What do you think was happening in the photograph?
- 3. When do you think the picture was taken?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. What is happening on the incline?
- 2. What do you notice about the neighborhood?

Level III: Analysis

- 1. What was the purpose of the incline?
- 2. Why don't we still use inclines?
