## **Level I: Description**

- 1. What do you think this is a picture of?
- 2. What details do you see in this photograph?

## **Level II: Interpretation**

- 1. What do you notice about how the men are dressed in the photograph?
- 2. What do the men look like they are getting ready to do? How do you know?

## Level III: Analysis

- 1. Can you explain what these men are trying to accomplish?
- 2. What does this photograph tell you about this period in history?
- 3. What time in history does this photograph occur?
