Allow students, in groups or individually, to examine the attached photograph while answering the questions below in order. The questions are designed to guide students into a deeper analysis of the source and sharpen associated cognitive skills.

Level I: Description

- 1. What materials is this house made of?
- Does the house seem large or small?
- 3. Where do you think this house is located?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. What do you notice about the surroundings of this house?
- 2. Do you think there are any other structures near this house?

Level III: Analysis

- 1. Why might the location of this house be beneficial to use on the Underground Railroad?
- What do you think the interior of this house might look like?
- 3. What can you infer about the people who lived in this house?
