Allow students, in groups or individually, to examine the attached photograph while answering the questions below in order. The questions are designed to guide students into a deeper analysis of the source and sharpen associated cognitive skills.

## **Level I: Description**

- 1. What do you see in this photograph?
- 2. What is the gender of most of the people?
- 3. Are there people of the other gender as well?
- 4. What do you notice about the building where they are standing?

## **Level II: Interpretation**

- 1. Based on what you notice about the building, do you think this is a place of importance?
- 2. What can you use to determine the time period of this photograph?
- 3. If there were no date, what else could you use to determine the time period of this photograph?

## **Level III: Analysis**

- 1. Based on what you know about the time, why do you think these people have gathered around this important building?
- 2. What does this tell you about how and why people gather around?
- 3. Can you tell me if they are successful in their gathering at that time? At a later date?
