Level I: Description

- 1. Where was this photograph taken?
- 2. What is in the vats?
- 3. What details do you see in the photograph?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. What questions would you ask one of the men in the photograph?
- 2. Why do you think the company uses such big vats?
- 3. How do they get the product out of the vats?

Level III: Analysis

- 1. What is the purpose of the equipment hanging from the ceiling?
- 2. What changes would you make to improve the factory?
- 3. What would happen if all the workers guit?
