- 3. What is the famous event in history?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. What do you notice about the soldiers in the picture?
- 2. Which side seems to be losing? Why are they losing?

Level III: Analysis

1. Do you think Paul Revere is a Patriot or a Loyalist? Explain your answer.
