- 3. When was this picture taken?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1. What are these men doing?
- 2. Why are they using horses?
- 3. Why are they using trucks?

Level III: Analysis

- 1. What does this picture tell you about farming during this time period?
- 2. How might this farming job be handled now?
- 3. Which method do you think is the most effective?
