Allow students, in groups or individually, to examine the photograph while answering the questions below in order. The questions are designed to guide students into a deeper analysis of the source and sharpen associated cognitive skills.

## **Level I: Description**

- 1. Where was this photograph taken?
- 2. What do you see in the photograph?
- 3. What details do you see in the photograph?

## Level II: Interpretation

- 1. What is different about our town and the town in the photograph?
- 2. What transportation do we use today in towns (cities)?
- 3. Why don't people ride horses to town today?

## **Level III: Analysis**

- 1. Compare the town in the photograph to our town today.
- 2. What is the function of the horse and buggy compared to our cars?
- 3. Would it be better if we rode a spaceship into town in the future? Why or why not?
