Level I: Description

- 1 What are the men in this photograph wearing?
- What are the men in this photograph doing?
- 3 Is there a date posted on this photograph?

Level II: Interpretation

- 1 Where do you think these men are?
- When do you think this photograph was taken?
- What kind of emotion can you see in the men's faces?

Level III: Analysis

- 1 What does this photograph tell us about army life during this time in history?
- What can you tell me about the relationships these men shared with each other in everyday life?
- 3 How would you go about finding out how many people got drafted?
